### SJSU Transportation Solutions Fall 2011 Student Commute Survey Report

## 1 Survey

Transportation Solutions (TS) completed its eleventh annual survey administered at the end of fall 2011 semester. This was TS's ninth online survey using <u>zoomerang.com</u>. The survey produced significant results that prove this department's effectiveness in reducing reliance on single occupant vehicles and meeting the modal shift targets.


The survey instrument was the same used in previous years. The questionnaire had been approved by TS grant source, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA Regional Funds).

The survey was carried out from November 1<sup>st</sup> through 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011. It was placed on the web and an email with the survey's link was sent to 34,130 students (Regular enrollment, Open University, Special Sessions, etc.); 4,172 participated with a response rate of 12.2%.


## 1.1 Analysis

This survey produced consistencies in all response ratios compared with the previous years' results. Since 2010, the overall alternative transportation usage increased 1.8% at 48.5%. Extrapolated over the population of 34,130, alternative transportation users were estimated at 16,553 in 2011. The local transit (VTA) ridership to campus increased 1.6% at 33.1% or 11,314 riders in 2011.

#### SJSU alternative transportation usage trends






The chart below shows the decrease in drive-alone rate to campus among SJSU students since fall 2001.

The solo-driving to campus decreased 2.6% from 40.0% in 2010 to 37.4% in 2011. The total transit users (local and regional) made up 38.0% or 12,958 riders.


Bicycling to SJSU has been on the rise for some time as the following chart indicates. In 2011, 3.5% of the population or about 1,178 biked to campus.



The average biking distance to SJSU was 2.1 miles (Q5xQ9).



The following chart shows the current commute situation at SJSU:



Other significant findings are as follows:

- a) Average frequency of travel to/from campus: 3.91 days per week, from the results of Question 4
- b) One-way trip distance (home to campus): 13.7 miles (average), from the results of Question 9.
- c) Number of days per week using transit/carpool/alternative commute mode: 3.92 days/week, from the result of Q4xQ5
- d) Mode of travel when not using transit:

The responses from Questions 5 provide the percentages for all the commute modes. Based on this, of the 34,130 students:

- 37.4% or 12,765 drive-alone,
- 7.1% or 2,423 carpool/drop off,
- 3.5% or 1,178 bike,
- 13.3% or 4,539 walk/skateboard/scooter
- 0.8% or 273 use other modes
- e) Mode of travel prior to use of Transportation Solutions services The results of questions 17 and 18, mode of transportation before and after using TS services show:

 f) Net reduction in vehicle trips to campus (based upon prior travel mode): The TS effectiveness in reducing drive-alone rate was 10.7%. Population 34,130 x 10.7% decrease in drive-alone = 3,652 cars x 2 trips/day = 7,304 trips/day

- g) 27.9% (4,618) of the alternative transportation users drove-alone to an initial transit stop or carpool pick up site (Question 11).
- h) The average one-way distance to initial transit stop or carpool site was 1.6 miles (Question 12).

Also other important results include:

- 51.7% of the new students use alternative transportation to campus (Q2xQ5). VTA ridership among new students was at 34.4%.
- 35.4% of the commuters who always have access to a car and 78.9% of the people who sometimes have access to a car choose to take alternative transportation to campus (Q3xQ5).
