SJSU Transportation Solutions Fall 2016 Student Commute Survey Report

1 Survey

Transportation Solutions (TS) completed its sixteenth annual survey administered at the end of fall semester. This was TS's fourteenth online survey and it was administered by SurveyMonkey.


The survey was carried out from November 1st through 15th. The survey's link was sent to 33,667 students (Regular enrollment, Open University, Special Sessions, etc.); 4,974 participated at a response rate of 14.8%.

The survey instrument was the same as previous years and as before, the results has proved the TS effectiveness in reducing reliance on single occupant vehicles and meeting the modal shift targets.

1.1 Analysis


This survey produced consistencies in all response ratios compared with the previous years' results. However, due to opening of a new campus housing complex, there was a 1.9% (over 600) increase in walking rate which has generated a shift in the modal split in 2016. The overall alternative transportation usage was at 45.9%. Extrapolated over the population of 33,667, the total alternative transportation users were estimated at 15,466. The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) ridership to campus was at 31.8% or 10,701 riders in 2016. The rate for walk/skateboard/scooter was at 17.3% (5,828).

SJSU alternative transportation usage trends




The total transit users including VTA (31.79%) and regional transit (5.21%) made up 37.00% or 12,454 riders. The solo-driving to campus increased 3.22% from 32.89% in 2015 to 36.11% in 2016. The chart below shows the history of drive-alone rate to campus among SJSU students since fall 2001.




In 2016, 2.77% of the population or about 934 biked to campus. The following chart shows the history of bike ridership to campus.



The average biking distance to SJSU was 2.5 miles (Q5xQ9).

Other significant findings are as follows:

- a) Average frequency of travel to/from campus was 4.05 days per week, from the results of Question 4
- b) Average one-way trip distance (home to campus) was 13.0 miles, from the results of Question 9. Average time of commute was 31.4 minutes (Question 10). The following tables list the average one-way trip distance for each type of commute mode (Q5xQ9).

- j) Mode of travel when not using transit: The responses from Question 5 provide the percentages for all the commute modes. Based on the 33,667 enrollment, the numbers for non-transit commuters are extrapolated:
 - Drive-alone plus Drive to Park & Ride was 36.1% or 12160,
 - Carpool & drop off 6.2% or 2,074,
 - Bike 2.8% or 935,
 - Walk/skateboard/scooter 17.3% or 5,822
 - Other modes 0.6% or 217

 Population 33,667 x 6.1% decrease in drive-alone = 2,054 cars x 2 trips/day = 4,108 trips/day
- m) 22.7% (3,303) of the alternative transportation users drove-alone to an initial transit stop or carpool pick up site (Question 11). Calculations: 22.7% x {Total transit riders (37.0%) + Total carpoolers (6.2%)} x 33,667= 3,303

Also other important results include:

- 48.9% of the new students use alternative transportation in their commute to campus (Q2xQ5). VTA ridership among new students was at 35.1%.
- 27.7% of the commuters who always have access to a car and 74.9% of the people who sometimes have access to a car choose to take alternative transportation to campus (Q3xQ5). VTA ridership among always have access to a car was 17.7%, and among sometimes have access to car was 49.0%.
