# **Internship Ready Canvas Modules**

The Career Center has developed online course content to support students in:

- 1. Preparation of successful internship acquisition
- 2. Professional development during internships
- 3. Assessing and marketing of transferable skills developed during internships
- 4. Developing plans for next steps upon completion of internships.

### Method:

- Short introductions to concepts under "Things to Read & Watch"
- Practical assignments to practice skills and assessment under "Tasks to Complete"
- Approximately 5-8 hours to complete all modules (depending on how faculty determine to assign and schedule deadlines)

### How to get started:

There are two ways in which students can access the modules:

- Set up a section within the course for their class. Faculty are then added as the course instructor for their own section and can add their students into that section. Changes to the content and layout of the course cannot be changed as it would affect all sections within the course.
- 2. Review the modules and have one or all imported into their own canvas course and they can adapt format or assignments as needed. *In this case, the career center asks that faculty share the learning outcome surveys built into each module with their students in order to track outcomes and assess for improvements/adjustments.*
