If you are applying to one of these programs, follow the instructions below to complete your self-evaluation. If it is determined that you are not applying or intending to enroll in SJSU, your request will not be considered.

1. Enter the SJSU course listed in the table or enter an equivalent course in the appropriate column.
2. Use SJSU's Articulation Office to look up course equivalents..
a. For CA community colleges, use "Course to Course Articulation"
b. For all other institutions, use the "Transfer Evaluation System (TES)"
3. ENTER the sem/grade for each course. Note: Grade earned must be C or above to count as equivalent.
4. If you have entered an equivalent course in each row of one or more subtest sections (I, II, and/or III), SUBMIT your request by UPLOADING your completed self-evaluation form HERE. IMPORTANT NOTE: Do not submit your worksheet if there is at least one open row in each of the subtest sections. You will instead need to take the Multiple Subject CSET or take additional courses.
5. You will receive a confirmation email within 5 business days that your request was received.

## EVALUATION TIMELINE:

The evaluation process is $4-6$ weeks. If you have not heard back after 6 weeks, you may contact Credential Services at credentials@sisu.edu to check on the status of your request.
