Recent & Upcoming Changes in CHHS

Nursing:

- All prospective Nursing students apply to "Pre-nursing undeclared" major in Cal State Apply and not "RN to BSN"
- NUFS 8 will become a major requirement beginning Fall 20, Nursing is advising that this course or its equivalent be completed or in progress at time of application
- Proposal to shorten program to 5 semesters of nursing coursework
- Past health care experience may be considered in the future
