Changes to the English, Concentration in Professional and Technical Writing Major as of Fall 2017

Starting in Fall 2017, most of the upper division English courses will be offered as 4 unit courses; the only courses that will not be transitioning to 4 credits are ones that currently fulfill GE (SJSU studies Areas Z, S, and V). In addition, we are revising our current sophomore survey requirements into a three sequence, TransAtlantic survey to explore the conversation between English and American Literature.

This transition will place more of your study within upper division courses, and while it will reduce the total number of classes that you will take, it will expand the breadth of these courses. The 4 credit courses will provide additional depth to your exploration of the material, either in additional reading, additional assignments, or differently designed delivery of the material.

The total number of units required for the English, Concentration in Professional and Technical Writing major is changing from 48 to 49-52.

CATALOG RIGHTS: Students retain the right to graduate under the catalog rules in effect <u>during their first semester at SISU</u>. Students who enrolled at SISU before Fall 2017 are therefore entitled to graduate under the old model (48 units). Students who enrolled at SISU in Fall 2017 or later must complete the requirements listed for the new model above.
