Three reasons why you need insurance

Things happen. A serious illness or even a simple accident could leave you with devastating bills. One visit to the ER can cost \$3,000 or more.

It can keep you healthy. Insurance pays for doctor visits, hospital care, prescriptions, emergencies and more. Preventive care is free.

It's the law. In 2014, most Americans will be required to have insurance or pay a penalty.

How much will insurance cost?

Maybe less than you think. Premiums listed below are for plans considered to be the best value. Insurance in these plans will cover 87% of your health care costs. Lower premiums <u>are</u> available, but come with higher consumer cost-sharing, like deductibles and co-payments.

Rates where you live may be slightly higher or lower.
