General Information

The minor in Mexican American studies is a unique interdisciplinary program of study that supplements any undergraduate major by providing a well-rounded introduction to Chicano/Latino communities, including their histories, cultures, and politics.

To complete a minor in Mexican American Studies, you need 18 units (six courses) from the following options:

You can take up to three lower division courses, or all upper division courses to complete the minor. You also may count up to two approved courses from another institution (see "Course Substitutions" below).

Instructions for Declaring a MAS Minor

- 1. Complete an official SJSU Addition/Change of Minor Form. There are two versions of the form: one for students with <u>fewer than 90 units</u> (www.sjsu.edu/registrar/docs/major_minor_less_than_90.pdf) and one for those with <u>more than 90 units</u> (www.sjsu.edu/registrar/docs/major minor more than 90.pdf).
- 2. Fill out the MAS Department Minor Form. In "Courses to Satisfy the Minor," indicate which courses you have completed, are in the process of completing, or those you plan to complete in order to satisfy the 18 units. Be sure to include the semester and year you took the class, the final grade and the course units.
 - If you are unsure of how to complete this section, please feel free to request an appointment with the Minor Advisor and bring your transcript(s) in order to fill in the appropriate information.
- Request an appointment with the Minor Advisor, Dr. Magdalena Barrera, to set up an appointment for review and signature. Please print an unofficial copy of your transcript and bring it with you to the meeting.
- 4. If you are a graduating senior, the minor form must accompany your graduation packet.

Course Substitutions

In the event that you do not take all the courses that you list on your original minor form, you can make substitutions within the Mexican American Studies department. Please see the Minor Advisor for approval of new courses and to fill out an <u>SJSU Substitution Form</u> (http://www.sjsu.edu/registrar/docs/substitution_form.pdf).

You may petition for an alternate course to be included in your program of study, or up to two courses that you already have taken at another college or university. Course substitutions must be presented in writing with supporting materials (i.e. syllabus and a transcript indicating the units and final grade) to be evaluated by the Minor Advisor.
