Philosophy 109-80 and Religious Studies 109-80 Synchronous ONLINE: Tuesdays and Thursdays 1:30-2:45 p.m.

This course surveys ideas, terms and concepts in religious belief and expressions, religious literacy, religions and gender, politics and power. Our study includes religions of East/West origins.

Topics: feminist philosophy of religion, non-religious studies, metaphysics of the Incarnation, hermeneutics and exegesis; atheism, anti-theism, and, ontotheology. Consideration of how secularism has challenged religions by considering '*Death of God*' and other radical theologies. Students will explore consequences of secularism on a religion of their choice.
